All classes are run under [Pony Club Showjumping Rules 2026](#).

Classes are Pre-entry. **No times will be given**, we will run to class order, please join Show whatsapp group via link on booking conformation email when entering, to keep an eye on running of the day! **Ring 2** is aimed at young or novice combinations. Please be honest and enter in the spirit in which it's intended. No spurs allowed in Ring 2. Maximum of 3 consecutive classes per horse/pony. A pony may only be ridden in TWO CLASSES in Qualifying classes.

Teams will only be in qualifying classes.

**Mini Champ entry conditions – see below**

**Assisted- This means someone in the ring with the rider, but not leading, touching the pony/rider, and not jumping the jumps on foot.**

### **DRESSAGE RULES:**

All tests will be conducted and judged in accordance with [The Pony Club Dressage Rules 2026](#) & [Pony Club Eventing Rules 2026](#) Class 16 & 17 may be ridden in any normal riding bit and grass reins as per current pony club rules. Riders must wear the correct clothing. If entries are low, some classes may be combined. Tests may be downloaded from Entry Master or PC website. All tests may be called. Numbers to be worn whilst warming up as well as during the test. **Please adhere to your times, any changes will be made at the Judge's discretion.**

## Rules and Conditions of Entry

1. This competition will be run in accordance with the Pony Club Rules 2026 The decision of the Judges, Organisers and Jury is final. They reserve the right to alter, amend or cancel any part of the competition, or refuse entry without stating a reason.
2. In the event of cancellation, entry fees - £10 to cover administration costs per rider, will be refunded by 16th July 2026
3. Entry Fees will only be refunded up to the closing date, 9th June 2026 After this date, No Refunds.
4. **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY.** Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
5. The Beaufort Hunt Pony Club takes the privacy and safeguarding of children at Pony Club very seriously. The only external photographers that are permitted to take images of the children at any of our Pony Club events are those directly engaged by the organisers and these images will never be used for any external media, advertising or promotion other than with the express written permission of the parents.
6. **ALL HORSES/PONIES ATTENDING BEAUFORT HUNT PONY CLUB EVENTS MUST HAVE A CORRECT VACCINATION HISTORY AND HAVE BEEN VACCINATED AGAINST EQUINE FLU WITHIN THE LAST 12 MONTHS. THERE WILL BE RANDOM PASSPORT CHECKS.**
7. **HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY.** Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring, and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.
8. **HATS** meeting current Pony Club standards **MUST** be worn at all times when mounted. All hats **MUST** be tagged with a PINK hat tag, any hat without a tag must be brought to the Secretary's tent when collecting numbers to be checked and tagged.

9. **BODY PROTECTORS**, which are up to the current Pony Club standard (as in the 2026 Rule book) are recommended for Show Jumping If a rider chooses to wear an air jacket, it must only be used in addition to a normal body protector and in the event of a fall, it must be removed or deflated before continuing.
10. **SPURS** - Rider must have achieved C+ riding or the Spurs Test AND Hats must have a new YELLOW spurs tag if the competitor wishes to wear spurs in any class.
11. Any queries or complaints must be in writing and handed to the Organisers within 30 minutes of the incident together with a fee of £20 which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
12. **NO STALLIONS.**
13. No cantering outside the rings and warm up areas.
14. All dogs must be on a short lead at all times. Please kindly clear up after your dog.
15. There will not be a farrier on site.
16. **Non-Pony Club members must have their own insurance, and Tagged hat.**

## Mini Champs entry conditions

Open to PC members 14 yrs and under.

The Mini Championship, teams and individuals, qualifying classes are

**Class 8a** 40cm led (Ring 2) – rider age 8 years and under (no whips or spurs allowed)

**Class 8b** 40cm assisted (Ring 2) – rider age 11 years and under (this means someone in the ring with the rider, but not touching the pony, and not jumping the jumps.)

**Class 8c** 40cm unassisted (Ring 2) - this means the rider is in the ring on their own

**Class 1** 50cm unassisted -Ring 1

**Class 2** 60cm unassisted- Ring 1

A pony may only be ridden in TWO CLASSES.

A combination may compete in either lead rein and assisted or assisted and unassisted at Championships.

A combination is unable to compete in the 50cm, or higher, if they have competed in either 40cm lead rein or 40cm assisted.

Any combination of horse and rider may not compete where the height is 20cm lower than that at which they have previously competed.

If a combination is placed in the top 65 at Champs, they are unable to compete at the same level the following year.

If you compete at the Pony Club Regional Show Jumping or Eventing competition you may not enter the Mini Championships.
